We have over 300 animals here at the park. You can view some of them on foot, and others when you drive through the reserves. You're welcome to drive round the reserves as many times as you like, but last entry is at 5:15pm, so please keep an eye on the time.

There's a one-way walking route around the park to help with social distancing. This starts in Pets Farm, which can be accessed by the new path beside the dodgems. Please excuse the construction work at the entrance, we're having a new sea lion pool built.

Our Bird of Prey shows take place at 1:00pm, 2:30pm and 4:00pm, and you are also welcome to pop into the Bird of Prey Centre any time.

'Dinosaurs at Blair Drummond' are very popular, so there may be a queue. If it's busy, please feel free to skip this bit and pop back later. They're open until 5:30pm.

Lemur Land and the boats to chimp island are currently closed. However, we've built a new path so the chimps can be viewed on foot. Some of our rides are also closed.
