

# Junior Keeper Experience

Your Junior Keeper experience will allow you to get up close and personal with ponies, sheep, llamas, meerkats and much more.

You'll carry out a variety of tasks including feeding and mucking out. It's going to get mucky! We'll provide you with the overalls, but make sure you bring sturdy boots or wellies that you will not mind getting dirty.

## Arrival instructions

You should arrive at the Safari Park by 8:45am. Drive straight up to the Ticket Office (aim for the giraffe archway) where there will be a member of staff waiting to meet you. Take your tickets with you as these are scanned on arrival.

Before the experience starts, we'll need a responsible adult to read and sign our safety disclaimer on your behalf, and we'll provide you with some overalls to put on over your clothes.

## Example Itinerary

9:00 – 9.15am: Walk the horse to their day field

9.15 – 10am: Meet and handfeed the farmyard animals

10.00-10.30am: Clean out the Guinea Pig enclosure

10.30 – 10.40am: Horse field mucking out

10.40-11am: Meet the lemurs

11-11.30am: Meerkat feed

11.30am: After your experience ends you are welcome to spend the rest of the day at the Safari Park. Here's some information to help you [plan your visit](#).

## Please note:

- The itinerary may change due to animal welfare or health reasons.
- Participants must be aged between 10-16 years.
- Participants must be always supervised by an adult, and your voucher includes admission for one accompanying adult who is expected to remain with you for the duration of the experience.
- Pregnant women and women who have given birth within the last six months should not participate in the Junior Keeper Experience.
