We have over 300 animals. Some can be viewed on foot, and others as you drive through the reserves. You're welcome to drive round the reserves as many times as you like. The reserves open at 10am and last entry is 15 minutes before the safari park closes, so please keep an eye on the time. For obvious reasons, motorbikes are not permitted anywhere in the drive-thru reserves, and soft-top vehicles are not permitted in the lion and macaque reserves.

Bird of Prey shows take place at 1:00pm, 2:30pm, and 4:00pm.
You're welcome to pop into the Bird of Prey Centre at any time.

"Dinosaurs at Blair Drummond" is one of the best dinosaur attractions in the country, and you're welcome to explore our prehistoric forest as many times as you dare!

Lemur Land is great fun but you must wear a face mask at all times. This is because our lemurs have a higher risk of Covid infection than many other animals.

Chimp Island boat trips are not running at the moment. However, we've built a new path so the chimps can be viewed on foot.

Keeper Q&As take place on our animal platforms throughout the day. Keep an eye on the blackboards around the park for times.

Smoking/Vaping is only permitted in the designated smoking areas. The rest of the park is non-smoking.
